Dear Parents,

If you intend your child to take part in the English Section's Roman Catholic Catechism programme or an Ecumenical Group, for the school year 2008/2009, please fill in and return the attached form by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June. All children are welcome to participate.

Catechism lessons for Years 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 usually take place between 3.30pm and 4.20pm. Non-denominational groups for Key Stages 1 & 2 will also meet at this time. Year 4 is a Sacramental year when children prepare for their First Reconciliation and Communion. It is expected that they would have followed a catechism programme for the previous two years. Information regarding possible days, times and year groups is outlined in the grid below.

Next year we would like to extend catechism to the English Secondary section for Years 7 and 8. Catechism meetings would take place at 1.00pm or 3.30pm, so as not to disturb the academic timetable, and would aim to provide an informal and supportive forum for young people to continue exploring, developing and sharing their faith.

This year we have been fortunate to work with several English speaking priests and I am hoping that next year we will be able to organise some celebrations in addition to our Carol Service and Holy Communion Mass.
